"Stay with Us" Luke 24:13-35

I. He is with us in the Scriptures - John 8:31

They said to each other, "Did not our hearts burn within us while he talked to us on the road, while he opened to us the Scriptures?" vs 32

II. He is with us in Christian Fellowship - Matthew 18:20

While they were talking and discussing together, Jesus himself drew near and went with them. Vs 15

III. He is with us in Breaking of Bread - Acts 2:42

Then they told what had happened on the road, and how he was known to them in the breaking of the bread. Vs 35

IV. He is with us in Hospitality and Service - Matthew 25:40

They urged him strongly, saying, "Stay with us, for it is toward evening and the day is now far spent." So he went in to stay with them. Vs 29
