


Confirmation Sunday St. Peter's Lutheran Church June 4, 2023

After Papa died, I wanted to go back and sit with Mamaw. I talked to her and rubbed lotion on her hands. That was my way of showing her how much she meant to me. Because I know Jesus, I was comforted knowing that they went to heaven to be with Jesus when they died.

God has been so good to me and has shown me His love through my extended family and my church. My mom got her life straightened out and is going to church now with her fiancé. She is getting married in August, and I am very excited about Phil becoming my dad. I'm so very proud of her and him and am glad that I've been able to move back in with her and will have my own home with a mom and dad now.

Being in confirmation has taught me a lot. And being confirmed is my way of telling God I promise to follow Him, love, and worship Him.
