

As We Gather.....we look at the second phase of forgiveness.....the TRUTH of forgiveness! It is a difficult word to hear, because we find forgiveness difficult—both to receive and to give. However, it is also an urgent word, because receiving and giving forgiveness is central to our faith. Thus the circle of Christ's love, the TRUTH of forgiveness, expands ever wider to encircle others. This is not cheap grace. This gift of God's grace has no limitations and is not bound by conditions. Forgiveness certainly does not mean acceptance of sin, abuse, and violence against us. It does not give people license to hurt us or exercise strength and power over us. God's unconditional love displayed in the person of Jesus Christ gives us a blueprint to live by. Forgiveness is a gracious gift. That's the TRUTH! As Christ has forgiven us, we, too, are called to forgive one another.
