

How about when God calls? We hear in today's readings of the response of Jonah, who was reluctant to follow God's call. Like Jonah, in Baptism, God has called us on His spiritual phone, to follow Him in a life of sacrifice, humility, and yes....even death, in order to follow him. And through his calling, He promises that through us, others will also be called to a new life with him. A soul saving life! So it is important to OBEY HIS CALL!
