

As We Gather.....we witness in our gospel text the Baptism of our Lord which reveals to us the two testimonies about Jesus as our Savior. John wrote in his Gospel that when the Light of the world came into the world the world did not recognize it. The world loved the darkness more than the light. This was the constant challenge that Jesus faced his entire lifetime. Jesus came as the Light of the world but the world did not understand. Jesus taught and preached among the people, his people, yet they did not understand. Jesus performed miracles: healed the sick, calmed the storm, fed the five thousand, and raised the dead. Yet in spite of all this, the people, his own people, did not recognize Jesus as the Savior. At the end of his earthly ministry, even after all the signs and wonders, the religious leaders still did not recognize him. But yet, in the Kingdom of God, Jesus' baptism revealed that which the people could not see. He was the Messiah....He was the Savior, and there were both earthly and heavenly testimony to that truth.
