EPISTLE Romans 3:19–28

Now we know that whatever the law says it speaks to those who are under the law, so that every mouth may be stopped, and the whole world may be held accountable to God. For by works of the law no human being will be justified in his sight, since through the law comes knowledge of sin.

But now the righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the law, although the Law and the Prophets bear witness to it— the righteousness of God

through faith in Jesus Christ for all who believe. For there is no distinction: for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith. STATEMENT OF FAITH

Good morning, everyone, my name is Emma Spencer. Today, I will be sharing my statement of faith, which began at my baptism on September 22nd, 2013.



1 Peter 3:21 reads, "Baptism, which corresponds to this, now saves you, not as a removal of dirt from the body but as an appeal to God for a good conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ."

This verse encapsulates my faith journey so much. It emphasizes that baptism is more than a physical cleansing; it's about the transformative work of God and the Holy Spirit within us. They guide us toward a good conscience and a pure heart.

While some are baptized later in life after learning about the Gospel, I was baptized early on and grew up in environments where Jesus' Resurrection was discussed. STATEMENT OF FAITH
